**Houston PetSet** is a 501(c)(3) umbrella organization dedicated to making a difference by providing grants to animal welfare-related nonprofits in the Greater Houston area. Our goal is to help those who are “in the trenches” on a daily basis rescuing, spaying, neutering, fostering, adopting and protecting Houston’s homeless animal population.

**Houston PetSet** raises funds for other animal causes through fundraising efforts and events including our Annual Fierce & Fabulous Soirée held each September. With the funds raised, **Houston PetSet** empowers animal welfare and rescue organizations to alleviate the immediate suffering of homeless and at-risk animals and to seek long term solutions to animal overpopulation, neglect and cruelty for the health and wellbeing of the entire community.

To date, **Houston PetSet** has gifted over **\$1 MILLION** in direct financial support to dozens of charitable organizations. Critical funding is granted to registered 501(c)(3) animal-related nonprofits for the following purposes:

- **Promote a Long Term Solution:** Includes grant requests for spay/neuter services, trap/neuter/release (TNR) programs, shelter intervention and home maintenance models, education & advocacy.
- **Alleviate Immediate Suffering:** Includes grant requests for rescue, foster, adoption, transport, and health & wellness veterinary services.
- **One-Time Transformational Grants:** As funding becomes available thanks to the generous support of major donors, one-time, transformational grant requests may be considered for the purposes of capacity building and collaboration.

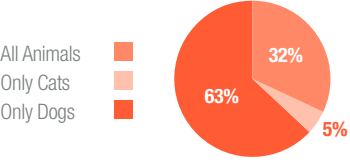
